

## Search tips for researchers

### Simple search

Just type a word or phrase into the search box and click on the **Search** button.

### Advanced search

An advanced search allows you to be more specific by using/combining

- issues / keywords
- public figures
- geographical indications
- historical events

Specify your search by **genre** and **period**.

Use the button **Index** to see the choice of indexes.

Check if particular search terms are available: e.g. you select 'keyword' from the index and type the word 'Hund' in the search field. You will see all items beginning with the word 'Hund', and can select from the list. As a search result you see lists, which you can click on in order to see individual titles.

The index lists do not contain the German umlauts, so „ä“ is „ae“ or „ü“ is „ue“!

The **Delete** button erases all information and you can enter a new search.
